MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL  
MARCH 9, 2022

Dear IHM families,

Earlier this week, we sent out registration papers for the 2022-2023 school year. You may have noticed a few changes between the paperwork for this current school year and next year:

- There is a 2.75% increase in tuition, resulting in an increase of about \$10 per month.
- We detail what it means to claim in-parish tuition (registered, worshipping, contributing).
- The price per service hour is now \$15/hour while the number of service hours is decreased to 30.

To be transparent, the decision to increase tuition was made after receiving your intentions to return and budgeting the cost to educate each child compared to tuition, fees, and what we hope to make through fundraising next year. Thankfully, our strong enrollment this year has allowed the increase to be minimal. After all, we are a non-profit organization and our goal is to make a Catholic education affordable for all. We understand that this financial commitment may still be difficult for some to uphold. Please know that tuition assistance is available. E-mail me to set up a meeting to discuss your options.

Lastly, I want to hone in more on the second bullet. Fr. Rolly and I are working together to strengthen the parish-school relationship. We are, indeed, a **parochial school**, and therefore must recognize that we cannot exist without the parish. **Therefore, if you are claiming in-parish tuition, you must be a registered parishioner at Immaculate Heart of Mary Church, providing your parishioner information on your registration paperwork.** We will be working with the parish staff to confirm your registrations status. Those who are not yet parishioners but are interested in joining can fill out a form at either the school or parish office. We will also

be reinstating monthly family Masses to encourage our families to gather and worship together. Thank you for your partnership and support in helping us strengthen our Catholic identity!

We have so much in store for this upcoming school year - new and exciting things for our 100th year! Stay tuned in the following newsletters for more updates about what you can expect. I am extremely excited and am looking forward to sharing all of this with you.


